### Scott Brown—Keynote

Scott Brown has been doing full time youth ministry for over 10 years. A frequent leader of Youth conferences at Montreat, Scott is known for his music and recreation leadership. He currently serves as the Director of Youth Ministry at First Presbyterian Church in Greensboro, NC. When not at the church, Scott enjoys spending time with his wife, Margaret, and 7 month old son, Noah. His hobbies include playing/listening to music and getting dirty in the art studio.

**Keynote - Sustainable Youth Ministry** is a book by Mark DeVries. But it is also an interesting concept. We often hear the word sustainable when we think about going “Green”, but what does that have to do with our ministry for children and youth? How can that idea help us in our ministry to young people? Join us for a discussion about the future of youth ministry at your church.

## Workshop Descriptions

### Session 1 10:30 a.m.

**Darkness to Light- Stewards of Children:** A Prevention and Response Program for Adults. This program is designed for adults interested in helping communities to end sexual abuse of children. The presentation will address issues related to making youth oriented programs and youth serving organizations safer for all children. This training is approved for 3 contact hours of instruction. Per guidelines of most states' licensing agencies, it's the responsibility of the licensee to keep documentation of attendance of continuing education and, upon request, to forward a copy of this certificate to the licensing agency as proof of such. The course will be facilitated by **Ginny Cartee**, Laurens School District 55 Special Projects Coordinator. *(This workshop runs for sessions 1 & 2)*

**Re-Create! – Live, Laugh and PLAY with a Purpose!** (Fundamental Building Blocks for Growing Groups). Mark Twain once said, “Work and play are words used to describe the same thing under differing conditions.” In this workshop, we'll explore a philosophy of play and the relationship of play to building the conditions for healthy group dynamics and learning. We will also explore essential elements of recreation leadership and experience practical activities and techniques for leading and debriefing groups in games, initiatives, and other activities. Kevin Cartee**, Outdoor Ministries Director for Trinity & Foothills Presbyteries and **Andrea Paschal**, Director of Children and Family Ministries, Forest Lake Presbyterian Church.
